Consul General Manjunath joined the Indian Foreign Service in 2004. Prior to assuming charge as Consul General of India in Houston in July 2023 (in charge of consulate operations in 7 states including Kansas) he was Joint Secretary in the Ministry of External Affairs, New Delhi, heading the Global Estate Management Division.

In earlier diplomatic assignments, he has worked in Indian Missions in Moscow, Astana, Colombo, and at the Permanent Mission of India to the United Nations in New York, in various capacities handling political, commercial, developmental, cooperation and multilateral work among others.

In stints with the Ministry of External Affairs, New Delhi, he served as Officer on Special Duty to the External Affairs Minister and Director in UN Political and Americas Divisions, and as Joint Secretary heading the Establishment Division and Rapid Response Cell.

A UN Disarmament Fellow (2012), he has strong interests in peace-keeping and Security Council matters. His specialties include Project Management, and executing medium to large scale construction projects.

Mr. Manjunath is a Distinguished Alumni Awardee from the College of Engineering, Guindy, Chennai, with a degree in mechanical engineering, and an alumni of Jawaharlal Nehru University, New Delhi. Prior to joining the Indian Foreign Service, he worked at TVS Motor Co Ltd, Hosur. Besides English, he speaks Russian, Hindi, Tamil and Kannada.
